30 APR

Quito (B, L)

Enjoy a privately guided city tour of Quito, the first city in the world to be declared as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. Enjoy lunch in a local restaurant followed by a visit to the equator where your guide will show the differences in the gravitational influence either side of the equatorial line.

1 MAY

Quito – Otavalo – Peguche – Cuicocha – Quito (B)

We head north for a full day of touring including the colourful market in Otavalo. The tour also offers a visit to Cotacachi, an Indian village famous for its leatherwork, and Cuicocha Crater Lake, whose wonderful scenery is dominated by mountains.

2 MAY

Quito – Galapagos (B, L, D)

We fly to the Galapagos where you will board your vessel, the M/V Legend, for a 4 night cruise. This afternoon make a wet landing at Mosquera Islet, a sandy island that has a large colony of sea lions. It is also an excellent site for observing shorebirds such as herons and Lava Gulls.

3 MAY

Egas Port (Santiago) and Rabida (B, L, D)

This morning make a wet landing at Egas Port, a black volcanic sand beach, visited by Darwin in 1835. The unique terrain of Santiago shore is home to a variety of animals including marine iguanas. In the afternoon we wet land on Rabida, considered to be the epicentre of the Galapagos Islands due to the diversity of its geology. Nine species of the famous Darwin's finches live here. Take a dinghy ride along cliffs to observe nesting seabirds, and snorkel off the coast, where marine life is particularly active.

4 MAY

Isabela - Urbina Bay and Tagus Cove (B, L, D)

We make a wet landing on a volcanic 'black' beach. After a short walk inland, enjoy snorkelling with the chance to see sea turtles and sea lions. In the afternoon, make a dry landing on Galapagos' largest island to learn about the five volcanoes that form it. The trail leads to Darwin's salt-water crater lake and excellent views of lava fields. Later, take a dinghy ride along a shoreline full of marine wild-life where you can admire a variety of seabirds such as Blue-Footed Boobies.

5 MAY

Fernandina to Isabela - Espinosa Point and Vicente Roca Point (B, L, D)

We make a landing at Espinosa Point, with the opportunity to encounter flightless cormorants at their nesting sites, Galapagos Penguins and the Galapagos Hawk. In the afternoon, you will have the chance to enjoy deep water snorkelling at Bolivar Channel, one of the richest marine havens on Earth, and take a dinghy ride along the coast to observe a great diversity of sea and coastal birds.

6 MAY

Santa Cruz and return to Quito for departure (B)

This morning make a dry landing at Santa Cruz. A 45 minute bus ride will take you a natural reserve with giant tortoises. This spot is also a bird watchers' haven since almost every land bird present on the island lives or migrates here. Following the morning touring we fly back to Quito for one night.
